

## Dimensional Variable Star

12" block

### Cutting:

Background: Cut (4) 3 1/2" squares.

Cut (4) 6 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles.

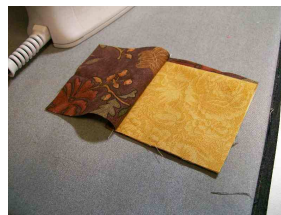
Star points: Cut (8) 3 1/2" squares.

Center: Cut (1) 6 1/2" square.

### Sewing:

#### Dimensional Flying Geese Units:

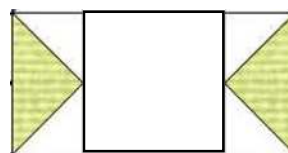
Fold (4) 6 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles in half the short way, WRONG sides together and finger press. Place (1) center background 3 1/2" square right side up, then place (1) folded rectangle on top of it, lining up the bottom and side edges. The top folded edge will be 1/4" below the top of the square. Place a second center background 3 1/2" square on top, wrong side up.



Sew along the right edge using a 1/4" seam. Flip open the sandwich and press. Open the center folded rectangle and spread to form a flying geese, Press OPEN. It will form a little arrow with the folded center piece. Repeat with the remaining three sets.

### Block Assembly

Sew one flying geese unit to either side of the center and press seams open.



Flying Geese

Sew background squares to either side of remaining flying geese units and press to the squares.



Join three rows to form final block, pressing seam toward the edges.
